WHAT WE DO

ShelterBox provides emergency shelter, aid essentials, and technical expertise at times of disaster, conflict, and climate crisis. There is no one size fits all solution, so we work together with local communities and our partners to adapt our response.

WHY WE DO IT

Home should be a place of safety and security, yet homes are torn apart by crisis and disaster every day. Right now, this is the reality for over 120 million people. Their lives destroyed and futures uncertain.

Shelter enables people to take steps towards their recovery after traumatic events and start to rebuild their lives. Shelter is a human right; the foundation for life, stability, and dignity.

OUR HISTORY

When ShelterBox started, we sent aid packages in our iconic green boxes - but we rapidly learnt from communities about the importance of adapting to the needs on the ground. This means that we no longer use the box, as we can deliver more tailored, innovative, and effective aid with different packaging.



DISASTER STRIKES

We immediately contact our partners on the ground to establish the scale of the disaster and how we can help.



A CUSTOMIZED SOLUTION

The support we offer is carefully tailored. That might mean providing a combination of tents or tarpaulins, blankets, mosquito nets, water filters and solar lights, or cash to empower people to choose the items they need most.



DELIVERY

We often go further, working with hard to reach communities to deliver emergency essentials people need to begin rebuilding their lives in the aftermath of disaster.



COMMUNITY RECOVERY

We don't just give people what they need to survive, we give them the tools to help them rebuild their lives – to keep families and communities together.

YOUR IMPACT

When a series of earthquakes hit Türkiye, Nurgül and her husband Imam lost their home. The earthquakes destroyed everything they owned, along with the life they knew.

Woken abruptly by the sound of shaking, they had only minutes to spare before their home fell to the ground. "We were being hurled from left and right. I shouted out to my husband. I said 'run, it's an earthquake' and we came out as the house was falling on us."

ShelterBox provided Nurgül with a tent along with other essential items such as a solar light, blankets, and a cooking set.
